
PROPINCY



THE JUDGMENT CONTINUES



Daniel has revealed to us the astonishing truth of the beginning of the judgment in 1844. We have seen that this pre-advent judgment deals primarily with the saints. This judgment is not conducted in order for God to find out who is going to be saved. God brings people into this judgment in order to reveal to the entire universe that these people that He is about to take to heaven are safe to be saved. Jesus Christ pleads their case, and He never loses a case that's entrusted to Him.

Another question arises: If the righteous are judged in the pre-advent judgment beginning in 1844 and ending at the second coming of Christ, when will the wicked be judged? Just as God does not need to have a judgment to find out who's going to be saved, neither does God need to have a judgment in order to find out who's going to be lost. The main purpose of the judgment is to ensure that everyone will be fully satisfied with the way that God has dealt with sin.

There are actually three phases to the judgment:

- 1. Pre-advent judgment 1844 to the Second Coming.
- 2. Judgment of the wicked during the 1000 years.
- 3. Execution of the judgment at the end of the 1000 years.

The judgment of the righteous satisfies the angels, while the judgment of the wicked will satisfy the righteous people of the justice of God. Therefore, this judgment of the wicked must occur after the righteous have been saved.
